

Rocky Mountain Iris

Iris missouriensis



Characteristics: Clump forming Iris with grey green straplike leaves and light to dark blue flowers. Grows in full sun to part shade. Prefers to be moist during winter and requires no extra water during the summer once established. Tolerates seasonal flooding. Height to 24 inches.

Native Range: Western North America

Landscape Uses: Perennial garden, Butterfly garden, Deer Resistant garden.
