

Purple Locoweed

Oxytropis lambertii



Characteristics: Perennial member of the legume family with clusters of pink or magenta flowers and finely dissected leaves. Height to 1 feet. Blooms in summer. Grows in full sun, in well drained soil, drought tolerant.

Native Range: AZ, CO, NM, WY, MT

Landscape Uses: Perennial garden, rock garden, butterfly garden, deer resistant

USDA Hardiness: Zone 4
